

➤ 1. LOG4J CRITICAL VULNERABILITY

On December 9th, a vulnerability has been detected in the Apache Log4j logging library, which is present in many applications, services and components developed in Java, and which may allow remote control of some systems. Its severity is estimated at 10 on the CVSS 3.0 scale.

A dedicated IDEMIA team has immediately been mobilized to analyze the Biometric Terminals products listed in Section 2 below. **No impact has been detected** at this stage and we will continue to monitor the situation and to keep you updated, if needed.

IDEMIA reminds you to follow these installation guidelines and best practices to enhance the security of your installation:


- Install the biometric terminals in an IP network behind a firewall. When possible, isolate it from the business network and from the Internet.
